REGISTER YOUR TRIP

Whether you're a first time or seasoned traveller, you should always register your trip at **smartraveller.gov.au** before you go.

It takes just a few minutes and it's free. Registering your travel plans will help us contact you in an emergency, be it a natural disaster, terrorist attack or family crisis.

To register, you will need to provide the following information:

- Name, date of birth and address in Australia
 - Passport details
 - Travel destination/s, including details of where you're staying
 - Arrival and departure dates
 - Overseas contact details
 - Emergency contact's details

You can also register at the nearest Australian Embassy, High Commission or consulate at your destination.

If you are travelling in a large group call **1300 555 135** before you go to arrange a group registration.

Your information will be handled in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988.

While you're registering on Smartraveller, you should also read and subscribe to the travel advice for your destination.
